APPLEWOOD RECOMMENDS YOU PROTECT YOUR PLANTS FROM FROST!

- **If you have any flowering plants or delicate perennials that have flowered, we recommend that you water your garden thoroughly before nightfall tonight. The soil will release moisture into the air around your garden during the night, keeping it somewhat warmer.**
- **Cover your plants before dusk. You can use newspaper, cardboard, plastic tarps, bed sheets or any lightweight material. Remove the covers once the frost has thawed to prevent overheating by the sun.**
- **If you are not able to cover your plants, wet any foliage with signs of frost damage in the morning. Do this before the sun rises.**

The above tips will help you protect your plants when a frost warning is issued.
